



# Congratulations and thank you for purchasing this livery pack from Mentour Pilot.

**Step 1:** Copy the downloaded zip file into your Microsoft Flight Simulator 2020 "Community" folder.

**For the Windows Store install:** C:\Users\[Your User Name]\AppData\Local\Packages\ Microsoft.FlightSimulator\_8wekyb3d8bbwe\LocalCache\Packages\

**For the Steam install:** C:\Users\[Your User Name]\AppData\Local\Packages\

*Important: Windows 10 by default hides the "AppData" folder, so you will have to go to "View" in the menu of File Explorer, and select "Hidden items" so as to see it.*

## For the Custom install:

If you happened to use a custom location for your Flight Simulator installation, then proceed there.  
eg. DRIVE LETTER:\Flight Simulator\Community\


## Another Method

Here's another completely different method that also works. While running MSFS 2020 do the following:

1. Go to Options / General
2. Click on "Developers" which you will find at the bottom of the list on the left
3. Switch Developers Mode on
4. On the Dev Menu select Tools / Virtual File System
5. The community folder location can be found under "Watched Bases"

**Step 2:** Unzip the downloaded zip file inside your community folder.

## Your file structure should now look like this:



That's it! Start the sim  
and fly like Mentour!

## \*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\*

When an update becomes available for Microsoft Simulator 2020 it is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that you copy the contents of your community folder to a location **OUTSIDE** of your sim installation (i.e. documents folder, desktop, external hard disk etc) and paste them back again once the updated has been completed. It has been reported that failing to do this can result in your community folder being erased.
